CHANGES AT SAINT PATRICK'S BASILICA

On May 31, 2018 our parking lot will close to the public, but remain open exclusively for parishioners attending Mass on the weekends. We will be entering into a time of change and hope that we can work together to resolve any issues with parking and your easy access to the Basilica. HEC Montréal, a university institution offering internationally renowned management education and research, is about to close on their purchase of our excess land, specifically the upper parking lot previously belonging to St. Patrick's Orphanage, and the western part of the land on De La Gauchetière formerly occupied by the Fr. Dowd Home that was ceded to the Basilica in 1985.

During the construction of the building we will find alternative parking for parishioners at the Basilica's

expense. Once the building is constructed we will have indoor parking available on Sundays and Feast Days with easy universal access to the Basilica.

What will this mean for Saint Patrick's?

1. All the original land belonging to the Basilica, dating back to the 1840's, will remain.
2. We will be able to better landscape and enhance the urban beauty of this land.
3. Our new neighbour, as an educational institution, is much better suited to our mission than other potential purchasers.
4. Parking for parishioners on Weekends and Feast Days will continue to be provided at no cost, for the foreseeable future.
5. Our financial future will be more secure and we will no longer be dependent on the operation of a parking lot!
6. The parking lot itself, not the most beautiful part of our landscape, will disappear.
7. The size, emplacement, height and exterior design of HEC's pavilion have all been addressed to our satisfaction.

Since the day in 2011 when we were first approached by HEC, we have worked hard to make sure that this will be the best fit for our Parish, its parishioners, its patrimony and its environment. We have used the services of experts in real estate, evaluation and negotiation but have never lost sight throughout of the Parish and our sacred mission.
