We will thus help the affected parishes in the spirit of solidarity, and also provide support to the parishes that have suffered material damages. 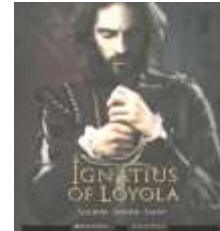
