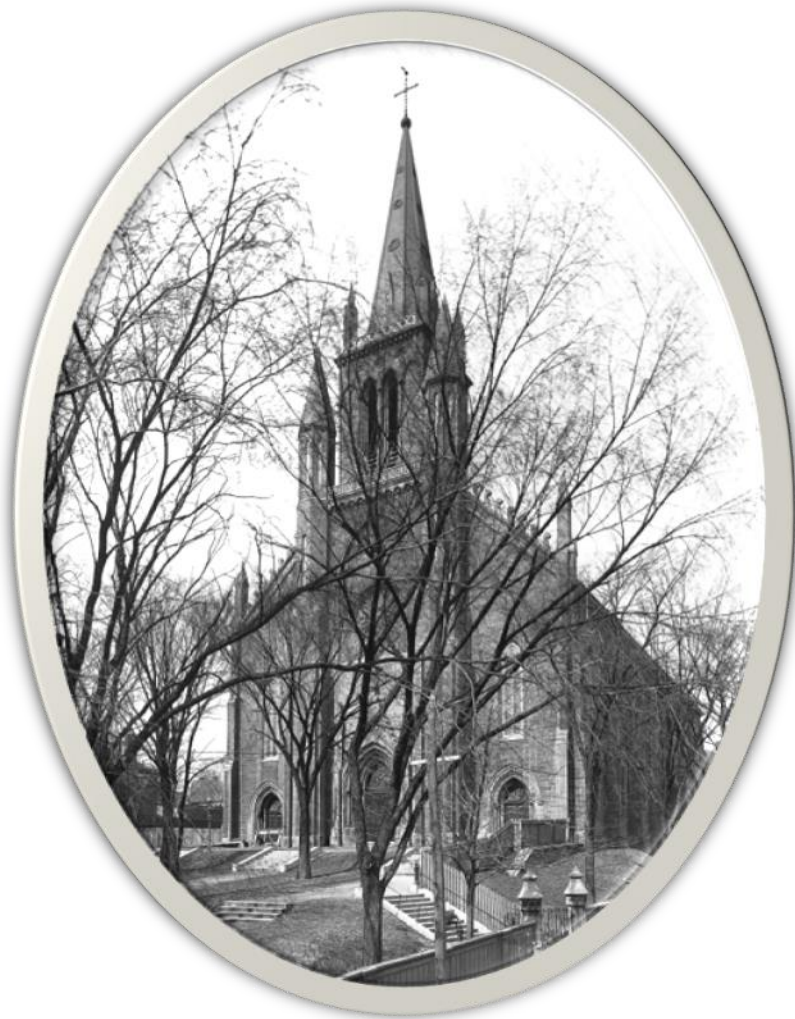

## ASH WEDNESDAY



Lent begins on **Ash Wednesday, February 14<sup>th</sup>**. Ashes will be blessed and distributed at the **12:10 and 5:00 p.m. masses**. The ashes we use are the burnt palms from last year's celebration of Passion Sunday. We begin our Lenten journey aware of where we are going. We want to enter into the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus for us more fully. That is the purpose of our journey. It is why we mark our heads with His cross. It is why we fast and abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday. *Fasting is for people from ages 18 to 59 years of age, and abstinence from meat is for ages 14 years and older.*
