

ROSE VESTMENTS - A TREASURE OF OUR TRADITION

Today is "Laetare" Sunday, "Laetare" is the Latin word for "Rejoice". As we express our joy this mid-Lenten Season, our Rose Vestments are worn on this particular Sunday in Lent, signifying the joy of the liturgical celebration in contrast to the usual purple vesture of Lent. (Except at the Green Mass which will be celebrated in Gold Vestments).

The Archbishop of Montreal, Christian Lépine, invites all the faithful to participate fully in the Holy Year 2025, proclaimed under the theme **Spes non confundit** (Hope does not disappoint). This jubilee year, which runs from December 29, 2024, to December 28, 2025, is a unique opportunity to strengthen Christian hope, encourage conversion and reconciliation, and pray for vocations in the service of the Church. **Saint Patrick's Basilica is one of the Jubilee sites.**

During this period, the faithful will be able to obtain the **Jubilee Plenary Indulgence** under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff).

All members of the faithful are called upon to demonstrate a spirit of penitence, in particular by rediscovering the value of Friday as a day of fasting, abstinence and moderation in media distractions. This Holy Year is an exceptional opportunity to renew our faith and hope, and to walk together as a pilgrim Church, united in prayer and charity.

HISTORY OF ST. PATRICK'S BASILICA

St. Patrick's Church was opened on March 17th, 1847 to serve the needs of the Irish immigrants who had come to Montreal in great numbers due to the famine and other troubles in Ireland. The church was built in the Gothic Revival style on a promontory overlooking the City of Montreal. Its spire could be seen by all. Over the years the city grew north, east and west with the result that the church is now surrounded by modern-day Montreal. St. Patrick's Church was raised to the status of Minor Basilica by His Holiness, Pope John-Paul II in 1989 because of its historical importance as the mother church of the English-speaking Catholics of greater Montreal. The Basilica has been designated a Historical Monument by the Government of Quebec and as a National Historic Site by the Government of Canada.
