

WORLD MISSION SUNDAY(Pontifical Society for the Propagation of the Faith)

Pope Francis' Message for the 99th World Mission Sunday (2025)

For the 2025 Jubilee Year celebration of World Mission Sunday, whose central message is hope (cf. Bull Spes non confundit, n. 1), Pope Francis chose the theme: "Missionaries of Hope Among the Nations." This theme is a reminder to every Christian — and to the Church as a community of the baptized — of our fundamental vocation: to follow Christ as messengers and builders of hope. "I wish everyone a time of grace with the faithful God who has given us new birth in the Risen Christ 'to a living hope' (1 Pt 1:3-4)." This Society is present in more than 120 countries and is the Vatican's principal organization supporting missionary activity in the poorest local Churches. It fosters global solidarity for the universal mission of evangelization through prayer and sharing. THIS weekend there will be a Second Collection for World Mission Sunday at all the masses.
